Additional Enrichment Programs

Ask is only one of a variety of enrichment programs available to SSDS elementary students. A separate registration is required for each program, included in the summer mailing packet or online on our website. (Band registration forms will be brought home by interested students in grades 3-5 during the second week of school).

- After School Band - Run by Paul Eifman Music on Monday afternoons and open to students in grades 3-5.
- Interscholastic Sports - Run by the SSDS Athletic Department on Mondays and Wednesdays for girls in grades 4 and 5, and Tuesdays and Thursdays for boys in grades 4 and 5.
- Friday After School Enrichment - Run by the Sid Jacobson JCC on Fridays from 1:30-2:45 pm for students in grades K - 5.
- Sunday Morning Sports League - Run by the SSDS Parent Association from 9:30 - 11:30 AM for students in grades K-5. There are three (3) leagues: Fall Soccer, Winter Basketball and Spring Baseball.

ABOUT THE ASK PROGRAM

ASK ELECTIVES—Fall 2011-12

Program Goals

Our After School Kids Program (“ASK”) provides targeted enrichment and Hebrew homework help.

- ASK is open to SSDS students only
- Class size is limited (7 minimum; 15 maximum, except for SSDS Theatre Club (Formerly Broadway @ Schechter with a maximum of 30), on a first come, first served basis
- ASK is not affiliated in any way with JCC’s Friday program
- ASK is one of the many after-school enrichment options enjoyed by Solomon Schechter students. (See Additional Enrichment Programs on back of this catalogue).

Cooking and Culture - Mondays, Grades K-2

While cooking and preparing foods from around the world, children will have a ball and learn about cultures, languages, people, and nutrition.

Hebrew Homework Helpers – Mondays (Grades 2-4)

Under the supervision of a Judaic Studies teacher, children will receive help with their Hebrew homework, and time permitting, will play fun and enriching games designed to strengthen their Hebrew language skills.

SSDS Broadway Theatre Club - Tuesdays Grades 2-5

In our Musical Theatre Program under the direction of Cantor Ethan Leifer our children will have fun and develop performance techniques in an environment of trust while gaining confidence and building self-esteem. A special production of the SSDS Theatre Club will be performed at a Sunday Matinee, April 22, 2012 by all students who enroll in both the fall and spring semesters.

Additional Information

- The \$330 fee for Cooking and Culture and SSDS Broadway Theater Club, and the \$300 fee for all other electives is per child per semester.
- After a supervised break for a drink and snack in a centralized location (from 3:15-3:30) students will go to their electives from 3:30-4:30 pm. The SSDS Broadway Theatre Club will meet until 5:00 pm.
- No transportation is provided. Some school districts offer a late bus. Check with your home district. If your child will be taking a late bus, please indicate so on the registration form. Students taking a late bus will be supervised until the late bus arrives.
- Students who are not picked up by 4:30 and are not taking a late bus will be escorted to the office and the family will be billed \$5 for every 5 minutes late, or any part thereof.

Fees and Payment Policy

- The fee for Cooking and Culture and for SSDS Broadway Theatre Club is \$330. All other electives are \$300 per child, per semester.
- Payment is to be made by cash or check. Please make checks payable to Solomon Schechter Day School.
- The program runs in 2 semesters and follows the school calendar.
- Registration for ASK will occur two times per year. Payment is due at the time of registration and there will be no refunds or make-ups for absences or missed classes.
