Under New York State law, students without up-to-date physicals and Sports Health Update Forms **will not be permitted to try out or participate in team sports.

***6th graders**, including SSDS Elementary students, require a Tdap vaccine if 11 years old and have not received a Td, DT or DtaP vaccination within the last two years.

Yellow Emergency Cards: complete the front **and** back of the card for **each** child.

NY City Residents ONLY: complete the Statement of Parent in Support of Health Service Claim for **each** NYC Resident Child.

Medications: A student requiring medication (ex: Epi-pen, Tylenol, allergy meds., Strattera, inhalers, Midol, etc.) during school or after-hour activities or who has permission to carry his own medication on campus must have the enclosed Medication Permission Request Form and the Self-Medication Release Form completed by a physician **every year**. Students who have permission to carry their own medication(s) must have **both** forms filled out. All medication must be brought to the Health Office for storage, unless the student has permission to self-medicate. The nurse **can not** dispense medication without this form on file. **You must provide your child’s own medication.**

Medical Ailments/Injuries: Any medical ailment, including surgery, casts, boots or crutches during the school year must be substantiated with a physician’s note and turned in to the Health Office.
