## ABOUT THE ASK PROGRAM

**Program Goals** Our After School Kids Program (“ASK”) will provide targeted enrichment and Hebrew homework help on Mondays and Thursdays.

- ✓ ASK is open to SSDS students only
- ✓ Class size is limited (7 minimum; 15 maximum, except for Broadway @ Schechter with a minimum of 30), on a first come, first served basis
- ✓ ASK is not affiliated in any way with the JCC’s Friday program.
- ✓ ASK is one of the many after-school enrichment options enjoyed by Solomon Schechter students. (See additional options at the end of Elective Offerings).

**Two Semesters** (Pricing is per semester)

- ✓ Semester 1: September 14th – January 28th
- ✓ Semester 2: February 1st– June 10th

After a supervised break for juice and a snack in a centralized location (from 3:15 - 3:30) students go to their electives from 3:30- 4:30 PM.

### Additional Information

- ✓ No transportation is provided. Some school districts offer a late bus. Check with your home district. If your child will be taking a late bus, please indicate so on the registration form. Students taking a late bus will be supervised until the late bus arrives.
- ✓ Students who are not picked up by 4:30 and are not taking a late bus will be escorted to the office and the family will be billed \$5 for every 5 minutes late, or any part thereof.

## ELECTIVES

### **Broadway @ Schechter - Thursdays - Grades K -5**

In our newly expanded Musical Theater Program, under the direction of Albert Hakim and our Music Teacher, Elana Stern, children will have fun and develop performance techniques in an environment of trust while gaining confidence and building self-esteem. A special Broadway @ Schechter performance will be staged for family and on Thursday, March 25th by all students who enroll in both semesters.

### **Hebrew Homework Helpers - Mondays (Grades 1 & 2) and Thursdays (Grades 3-5)**

Under the supervision of a Judaic Studies teacher, children will receive help with their Hebrew homework, and time permitting, will play fun and enriching games designed to strengthen their Hebrew language skills.

### **Scrabble Club and Math Olympiads - Mondays, Grades 2-5**

Learn the skills and strategies to play Scrabble and compete in an in-house tournament. Challenge your brain to work on the many varied and exciting aspects of math in the wondrous world we live in.

### **Computer Club - Mondays, Grades K-2**

Working with our computer teacher, the children will learn how to create different projects using advanced software programs.

### **Kitchen Science - Thursdays, Grades K-3**

With the guidance of our science teacher, the children will engage in hands-on activities and experiments using supplies typically found in and around the kitchen.

### **Additional Enrichment Programs**

A separate registration is required for each of the following programs:

- **After School Band** - Run by Paul Effman Music on Monday afternoons and open to students in grades 3 - 5.
- **Interscholastic Sports** - Run by the SSDS Athletic Department on Mondays and Wednesdays for girls in grades 4 and 5, and on Tuesdays and Thursdays for boys in grades 4 and 5.
- **Friday After-School Enrichment** - Run by the Sid Jacobson JCC on Fridays from 1:30 - 2:45 pm for students in grades K - 5.
