There are a number of enrichment classes that are offered for each semester. The programs described in this brochure indicate the appropriate grade level for each class. Some classes are cyclical, while others are continuous. Please review the course descriptions carefully. Many courses have a limited number of spaces. All applications are entered in the order that they are received to the JCC.

PROGRAM CLOSINGS

Whenever school is closed, the after-school program is closed. If Solomon Schechter cancels other after-school activities, this program is also closed. The after-school program may also be closed due to inclement weather. For this reason, please make sure that all emergency numbers are kept updated. FEES AND PAYMENT POLICY

The program runs in two semesters and follows the calendar listed below. Registration for enrichment classes occurs two times per year. Payment is due at the time of registration, and there are no refunds or make-ups for absences or missed classes.

The JCC offers a sibling discount of 10% for every child after the first (higher fee prevails). Financial assistance is available based on need. Please contact the JCC for an application.

Vacation Programs at the JCC/ Childcare When School is Out

Vacation programs give children the chance to spend their days off from school in style! Every day has a different theme and main activity period. The rest of the day, the kids participate in sports, optional swimming and arts 'n' crafts.

- ◆ Programs run from 10:00am–4:00pm.
- ◆ Programs are professionally staffed, with low 6:1 child-to-staff ratio.
- ◆ Activities are broken down by age group.
- ◆ Children need to bring a kosher lunch (unless lunch option is chosen), bathing suit, bathing cap, towel and change of clothing. Children are not able to swim without a bathing cap.
- ◆ 10% sibling discount for each child after the first.
- ◆ There are two additional options that you may consider for your child:

Kosher Lunch Program—\$6 per day

Extended Childcare—Great for working parents! We have activities starting at 8:00am and ending at 6:00pm (5:00pm on Friday). The fee is \$6 per hour, per child.
