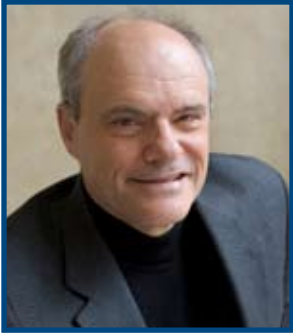

Dr. Kenneth W. Stein

Emory University*

Dr. Kenneth W. Stein is the William E. Schatten professor of contemporary Middle Eastern history, political science, and Israeli studies at Emory University in Atlanta, Georgia. Since coming to Emory in 1977, he has founded and developed the International Studies Center, was the first director of the Carter Center, and established the Institute for the Study of Modern Israel.

At Emory, he is engaged in precollegiate teacher training, curriculum construction, and long-distant learning on topics relating to Israel and the Middle East.

Dr. Stein has been recognized for making the school's curriculum international, having received many awards, including the Emory Williams Teaching Award for undergraduate teaching. In 2006, Dr. Stein was a visiting professor of political science at Brown University in Providence, Rhode Island.

The author of numerous books and publications, Dr. Stein's work includes *Making Peace Among Arabs and Israelis: Lessons from Fifty Years of Negotiating Experience* and Hebrew and English editions of *Heroic Diplomacy*:

Sadat, Kissinger, Carter, Begin, and the Quest for Arab-Israeli Peace. He also serves as president of The Center for Israel Education, a nonprofit organization focusing on preparing curriculum and instruction about Israel and the Middle East for precollegiate settings and for adult learners.

Dr. Stein earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Franklin and Marshall College, and two master's degrees and his doctoral degree from the University of Michigan. He studied for two years at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem.
